Dear Board of Health,

I noticed that the Wireless and Fluoride topics are not included on your 11/22/19 meeting agenda for discussion. I believe at the last meeting I heard member(s) requesting further review and discussion on these topics.

- BOH 08/30/19 Meeting- Requested the Board of Health review the Wireless Radiation (aka EMFs) health risks and consider safe, sustainable technology and procedural recommendations to help protect the students and teachers in Shrewsbury Schools.
- BOH 10/23/19 Meeting- Requested the Board of Health to notify pregnant woman of the recent JAMA Pediatrics study so that pregnant women can make an informed decision on whether or not they want to avoid drinking Shrewsbury's fluoridated water during pregnancy.

These topic are both very time sensitive because:

- For the Wireless topic, the Beal School is being built and time is running out for the Beal School Building Committee to consider safer technology like wired connections and on/off switches for routers for teachers to use to shut off routers when not in use.
- For the Fluoride topic, with pregnancy being only 9 months, each month that goes by means more babies exposed to fluoride throughout pregnancy without Shrewsbury mothers being informed of the potential risks of fluoride exposure during pregnancy and its link to lower IQ.
